## **Job Summary & Requirements:**

The Project Listo Bilingual Teacher provides a classroom experience to enhance self esteem, promote Spanish language development, and support homework and academic success for elementary children in the multi-level classroom at Listo. The teacher will provide a developmentally linguistically and culturally appropriate learning environment and the varied experiences necessary to develop social, intellectual, physical and emotional skills in a manner appropriate to their age and stage of development. The teacher also provides parents with opportunities to participate in the classroom. One year experience working with Latino culture is required. Fluency in the Spanish language is also required.

## **Education Requirements:**

An A.A.S. in Education, CDA, or a related degree in another field with a minimum of 30 quarter hours or 22 semester hours of approved credits in Education preferred. Relevant experience will be considered.

## **Hours Per Week: 10**

*This position requires evening work on Tuesdays and Wednesdays. May increase to include Mondays and Tuesdays for 10 additional hours if funding becomes available.*

**Number of Work Weeks per Year:** 32.7 weeks, beginning 10/05/09 and ending 5/30/10
