*** Teacher ***

Job Summary & Requirements:

A Teacher provides children with a developmentally appropriate learning environment in the classroom setting. They provide varied experiences for a successful kindergarten experience, helping children to develop their language, literacy, and numeracy skills in a manner appropriate to their age and stage of development. This position requires very high stamina and the physical ability to interact with young children. One year experience teaching preschool children required.

Education Requirements:

This position requires an A.A.S. in Early Childhood Education or a related degree in another field with a minimum of 30 quarter hours or 22 semester hours of approved credits in Early Childhood Education.

Hours Per Week: 39

Agency hours of operation are from 6:30 AM to 6:00 PM. Shifts vary and are as assigned.

Number of Work Weeks per Year: 39.4 weeks, *beginning 8/31/09 and ending 5/28/10*

Number of Layoff Weeks per Year: 13

This is an unpaid layoff, during which you may be eligible for unemployment benefits.

Starting Salary: \$12.49

Actual starting salary for this position may vary depending on education, qualifications, and specific position assignment.

Employment Contingencies:
