Hand Washing Procedure

Hand washing is required:

- 1. Immediately upon arrival at the center
- 2. Before any food related activity, including:
 - \checkmark entering the kitchen
 - ✓ preparing food
 - ✓ serving food
 - \checkmark setting the table
 - \checkmark before and after eating
- 3. After:
 - \checkmark using the bathroom
 - \checkmark wiping noses
- 4. Before and After putting on vinyl gloves for diapering.
- 5. Whenever skin may come in contact with blood or body fluids
 ✓ Vinyl GLOVES MUST BE WORN to prevent blood borne pathogen exposure
- 6. After administering medications
 ✓ Vinyl GLOVES MUST BE WORN to prevent blood borne pathogen exposure
- 7. After handling pets or other animals
- 8. Whenever hands are soiled
- 9. After emptying the trash

How to wash your hands:

- 1. Turn on water to a warm temperature
- 2. Wet hands thoroughly
- 3. Using soap from a dispenser, rub hands together vigorously for 20 to 40 seconds
- 4. Wash ALL hand surfaces back of hands, wrists, between fingers, under fingernails
- 5. Rinse hands thoroughly under warm running water
- 6. Dry hands with single use paper towels
- 7. Use the paper towel to turn water off
