

## Vomit Cleanup Procedure

1. When a child vomits, immediately get the Vomit Kit and put on vinyl gloves and a mask
2. Cordon off the area around the vomit
3. Assist the child to the bathroom to clean up. Remove and throw away your first pair of gloves and mask and take the child to the center's designated sick child area
4. Put on the second pair of vinyl gloves and second mask
5. Completely cover vomit with vomit absorbing product
6. When the vomit has been absorbed, scrape up the vomit with the scraper and put it in the red biohazard bag
7. Remove your gloves and mask and put them in the red biohazard bag
8. Put on chemical splash goggles and gloves and thoroughly clean contaminated surfaces with water. Spray with disinfecting solution; let stand for a **minimum of 10 minutes**; wipe with paper towel or allow to air dry
9. Using sanitizing solution, spray all surfaces within a 5 foot area around the vomit. Let sanitizing solution stand for a minimum of 2 minutes. Wipe down with paper towels or allow to air dry
10. When finished take the red biohazard bag and dispose of it in the outside garbage can
11. Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and warm, running water for at least 20 seconds. Dry hands thoroughly and use the paper towel to turn off water
