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Health Manager - Chalesa Duewall

As your Health Manager, I oversee the health and safety for all children in the program. I work closely with the Department Directors and Director team to ensure policies and procedures are current and meet our performance standards. I work alongside the Health team to ensure all needs are being met. I train center staff when children have special health needs or medications. I am also here to support you in your work of keeping our children healthy and safe at school and promoting healthy habits they can carry throughout life.





Health Coordinators - Catherine Hall and Justin Ward

Catherine & Justin are your Health Coordinators, who coordinate with the family services team to facilitate medical and dental exams, individual care plans, immunizations, as well as communicate with medical professionals to implement health plans. We work together to help train new staff, as well as visit centers monthly, to provide continued health support. By collecting, compiling, monitoring, and analyzing health statistics, we are able to work closely with center staff to better support the families we serve. Additionally, by communicating with the counties, we are able to ensure all children are up to date, or exempt, with their immunizations, thus helping to create a safe environment at school.



Health SAAs - Melissa Clark and Shelly Dykes

In our role as Service Area Assistant – Health we process Release of Information Results for Dental, Medical (ROIs) and assist with Hearing and Uision ROIs in support to Sherry Whaley as well as our Health Coordinators team Justin and Catherine. In processing these ROIs we help to ensure the children in our programs are getting up-to-date medical and dental care to support our agency standards for keeping kids healthy. Also, we process health supply orders for our Centers as well as purchase supplies as needed. Additionally, we support the Main Office by providing coverage when needed.

Health Screener Coordinator - Sherry Whaley

As Health screener Coordinator, I am responsible for screening all HS and EHS littles for hearing and vision, as well as referring kiddos to a specialist when needed, and following up on hearing and vision concerns with family services team.

New this year, I will be joining the EHS HB specialists in newborn/post-natal home visits and following up with new moms after baby is born to ensure mom, family and baby are adjusting well and feel supported in every way possible.
