Immunization Exclusion Day 2023

Immunization Exclusion Day is an Oregon State Law that requires all children in school and childcare settings be up to date or have a valid exemption on file. If they are not, they must be excluded from school until they are brought up to date or a valid exemption is completed.

I just wanted to let everyone know how much hard work has gone on throughout the agency! This takes a lot of work - and a lot of teaming! I know these conversations are not always easy to have with families, especially when we get down to the wire. I appreciate the work each of you did in helping families get their children up to date or in completing the VECC to keep them in class. It is always disappointing to have to turn children away when we want them here, but I wanted to show how few children actually ended up being excluded! We currently still have 4 children being excluded, but hope to get those resolved and back in class soon. For comparison, last year the agency excluded 16 children on exclusion day. I really want to point out how many families got their children up to date or VECC completed between 1/11/23 & 2/15/23!
