I. The new Safety Rep from Redwood is Tricia Krois

Tricia was just promoted from a CLA to a TA. Tricia was welcomed to the Safety Committee of JoCo.

II. The only delta (what could be improved) from November's meeting was:

"It would be good to have snacks and water provided." This was addressed by providing snacks and water during today's meeting.

III. The Monthly Safety Award Process was reviewed.

- A certificate and safety pin is provided by the Safety Rep to an employee who demonstrates safe practices in the workplace.
- The Safety Rep e-mails Laurie with the employee's name and a description of what the employee did to promote safety.
- Laurie enters the employee's name in the next month's Safety Meeting drawing.
- After a name is drawn, Laurie e-mails the winner to inform them of their Safety Employee of the Month award and their incentive gift choices (blue-tooth mini speaker, coffee mug, beanie, t-shirt, sweat shirt, or zip hoodie. The employee is also asked if they would like to be in the Weekly Memo as the Safety Employee of the Month.

IV. Workplace Inspection form

Laurie stated that this form is necessary not only to increase safety in the workplace, but also serves to meeting OSHA requirements of conducting a workplace inspection during months the committee does not meet.

The next month for JoCo reps to complete and submit an inspection to Laurie is February 2020. These inspection forms are required (3 times a year) by all reps in order to receive the \$50.00 stipend for participating on the committee which is awarded in May.

VII. Incident and Injury Reports

There were 16 incidents during the time period between 11/29/19 through 1/30/2020. Nine of these involved aggressive behavior directed to staff by a child. None resulted in the need for medical care. Other incidents may have been prevented by an increased awareness of the environment: for example: Cleaning behind a dishwasher and touching a hot water pipe; touching a hot pan in the kitchen; hitting head on the doorway of playhouse.
