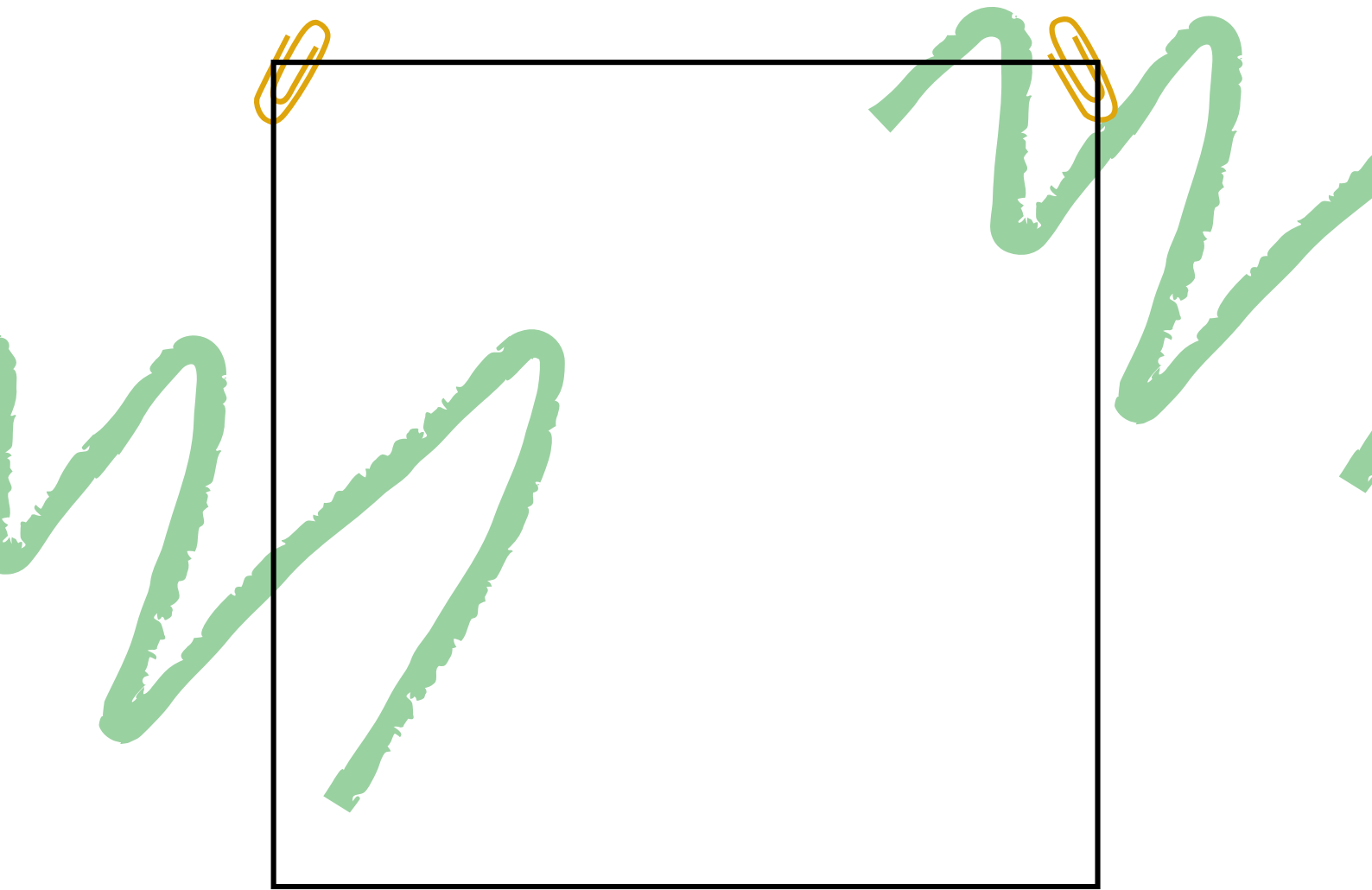

Same:

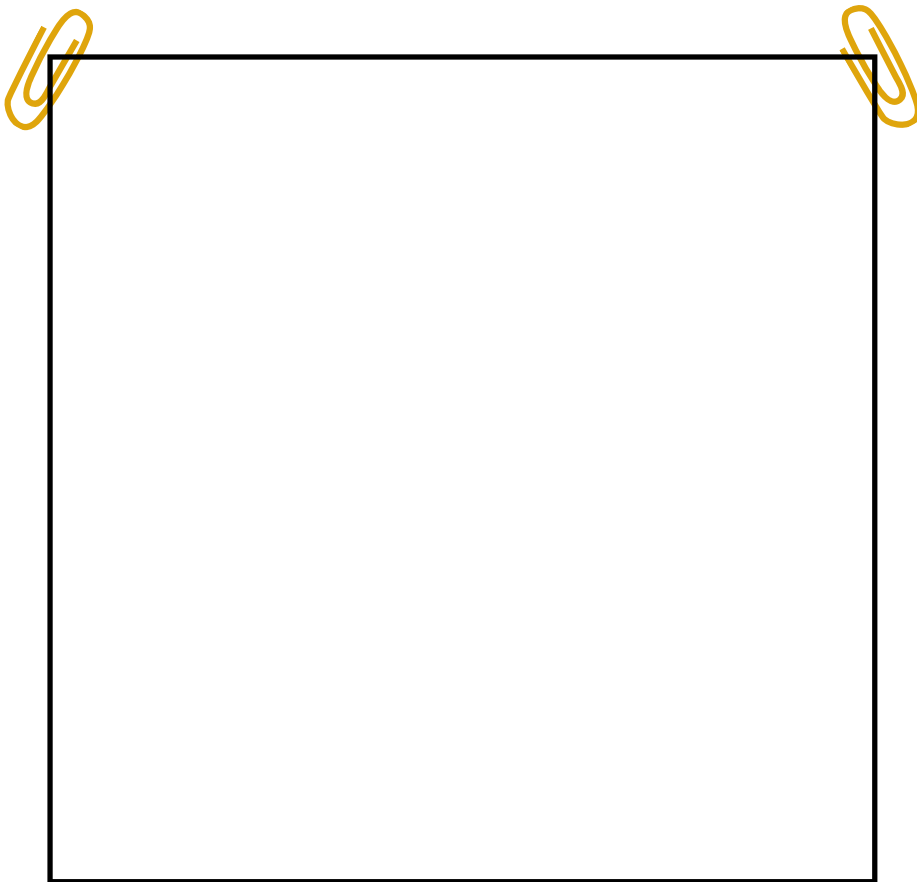
- I will play outside

- I will see a new playground

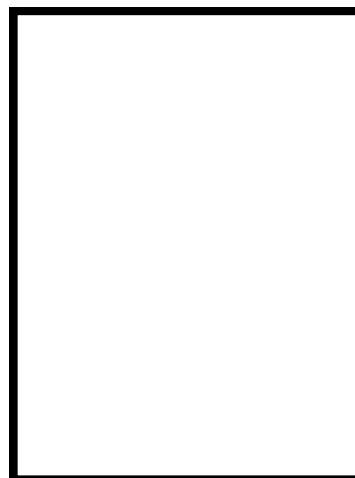
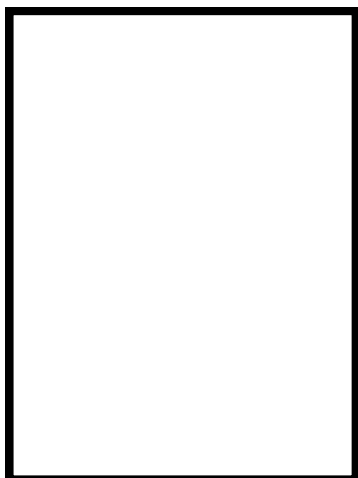
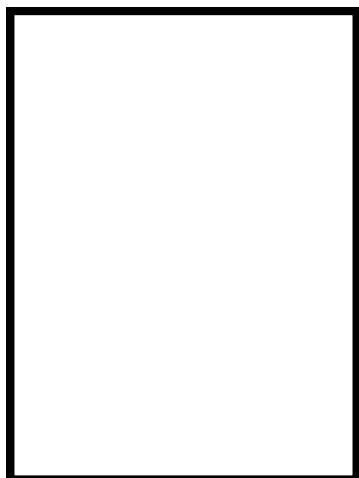
