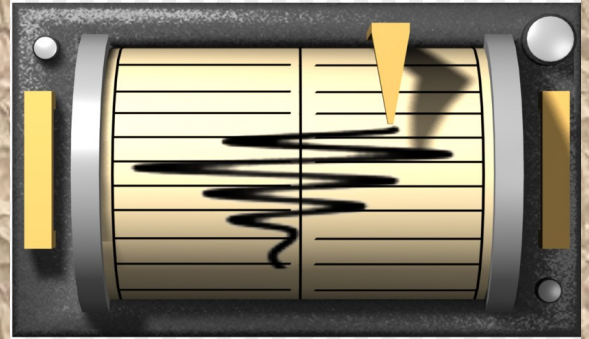
Hillside Center has been busy!!! The children have been learning about mazes, making trail mix, and home building (being the "Big Bad Wolf" and blowing down the houses!)

In October, LB Center staff held an Earthquake Drill to help teach our children to be prepared for this kind of emergency!

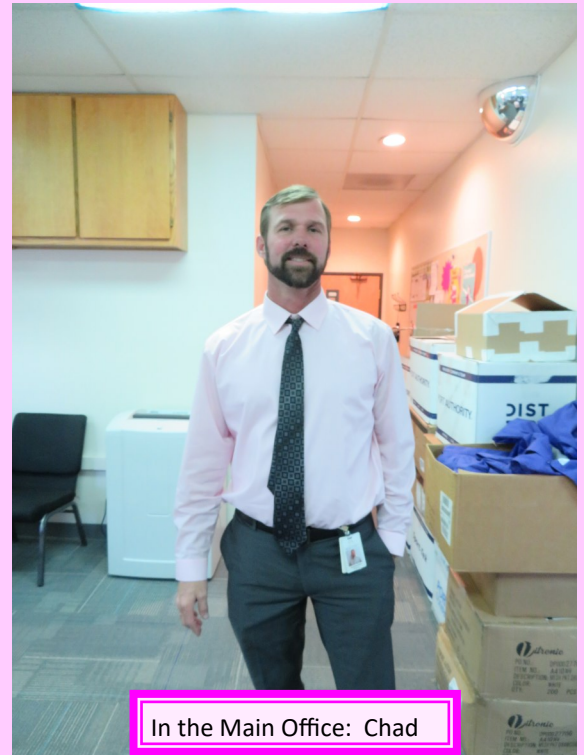

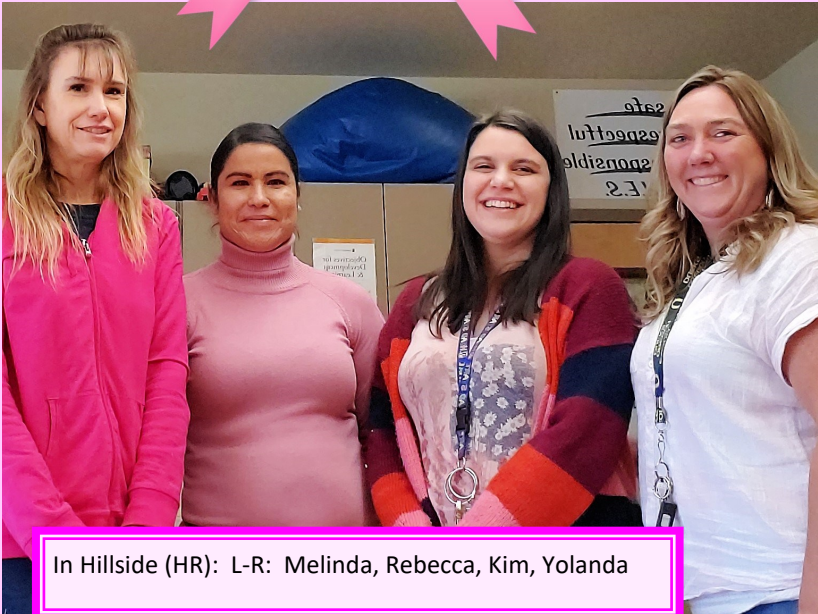

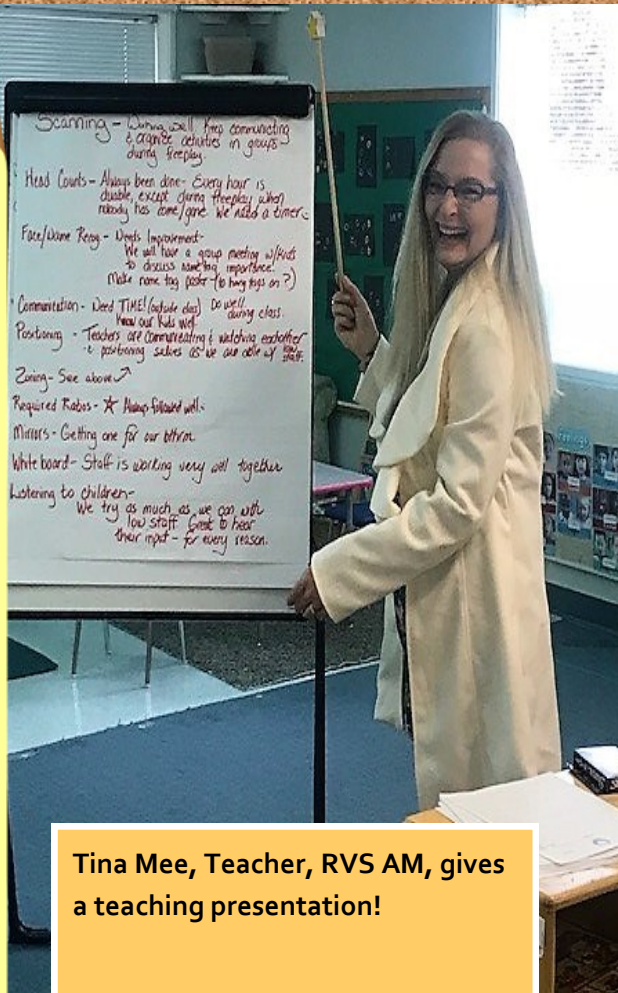
