



TIPS TO HELP KEEP YOUR CHILD LICE-FREE

- Never share brushes, combs, hats, towels, helmets, pillows, sleeping bags, etc.
- Always keep hair up in a bun or braid and use repelling spray.
- Store jackets and backpacks, etc. in separate cubbies or in a sealed bag.
- Comb through child's hair EVERY WEEK with a good metal nit comb to remove possible nits or lice. Focus on nape of neck, behind ears and top of head.
- Watch for signs of itching and scratching.

MYTHS ABOUT HEAD LICE

I'm a bad parent...

Absolutely not! This has nothing to do with personal hygiene or the cleanliness of your home.

Pets can get head lice...

Nopel Lice are a human parasite and require human blood only.

Head lice jump and fly...

Again, NO! Lice do not jump, neither do they have wings to fly with. They only crawl.

Everyone in the house must be treated..

Not quitel Everyone should be thoroughly checked (professionally if possible) but only those found to have lice or nits should be treated.

Head lice prefer long hair...

Not true. Lice do not care whether hair is short or long. They thrive in hair where they can reach their blood source through the scalp.

PREVENTING REINFESTATION!

#1 TIME-SAVING TIP...

If it's not dirty, Don't wash it. Throw it in the dryer on high heat for 30 minutes. If it can't tolerate the heat, bag it up and put it aside for 3 days.

BEDDING/CLOTHING

Wash/dry all bedding and any clothing that has been worn within the last 3 days. Don't forget about coats and hats.

FURNITURE/CAR

Leather/vinyl may be wiped clean. Upholstered furniture can be vacuumed. Household sprays are available but be sure to use one that is safe and non-toxic for the safety of your family and your furniture. Don't forget car seats!

STUFFED ANIMALS

Stuffed animals can be put in the dryer on high heat for 30 min (if tolerated) or bagged up for 3 days.

COMBS, BRUSHES & HAIR ACCESSORIES

Remove hair from brushes and combs and place in dishwasher. Hair bands and small items may be put in a small mesh laundry bag and run through the dishwasher as well. You may also put all items in a Ziploc bag in freezer for 24 hours.


