

While Dad was trying to take out the fire Paige called me, I was just a block out when I turned back as I was driving back, I called the High school office, and they sent an officer over while they call the fire station.

We supported the family with a blanket to sit and a toy for the child while they were trying to figure out their next steps. I advised the Dad not to turn the car back on. The fire truck came, and the fireman checked under the car for any further danger. All was good and the families ride arrived to take the family home. The tow truck will come tomorrow to pick up the car. I talked to the High School staff, and they said they will replace our fire extinguisher by tomorrow morning.
